F.Y.I. - GARBAGE AND RECYCLING

NORMAL HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE

All bagged refuse / garbage- goes down the chute. Normal, soft household waste (paper napkins, waxed paper, milk cartons and food wraps, etc.)

What doesn't go down the chute?

No Liquids.

Newspapers - neatly stack and leave in the corner on the compactor room floor. Cardboard - must be broken down & tied and left neatly on the compactor room floor. Glassware and Dishware (light bulbs, pottery, Pyrex, mirrors, etc.), aerosol cans, empty paint cans, etc. - these items may be bagged and left on the floor of the compactor room. Please rinse dishware and glassware prior to bagging them.

CURBSIDE PICK-UP

The Fort Lee garbage pickup picks up smaller bulkier items **Thursdays and Fridays**. Please place them curbside on evenings **after 6PM**. These items include but are not limited to **old chairs**, **suitcases**, **window blinds and small appliances** (i.e...toasters, microwaves, etc)

IWS-Interstate Waste Services at 1-866-342-5497 to make an appointment to have these larger items removed; only two (2) items at a time can be placed outside. White goods include refrigerators, stoves and air conditioner. <u>Special Note</u>: Remove the doors from all white goods. There is too much risk that a child may get trapped inside the appliance. It is the law and it is a good one.

Reminder: Computers, Electronic equipment and televisions must be disposed at the Fort Lee Public Works Dept. Dumpster, 530 Jane Street, Fort Lee, NJ 07024

You may be able to make arrangements with the vendor or delivery service for the removal of your old appliance.

BUILDING MATERIALS

Prior to having your apartment renovated, please be aware that **contractors are responsible for all disposals, from plaster and paint to appliances to doors to old lumber – and ALL professional contractors know it.** Building materials may NOT be placed outside for curbside pick-up. Make sure you settle this issue **BEFORE** they begin work.

CARPETING

Carpeting must be cut down and tied before placing curbside for pick-up on the specified days ONLY. You may be able to make arrangements with the contractor for the removal of your carpeting.
